We Share Solar empowers students to be global changemakers. By combining solar energy and engineering education with real-world applicability, trained educators cultivate students' interests in STEM subjects and inspire them to meet an immediate need in the developing world.

Who: Minneapolis and St. Paul area teachers and after-school program educators interested in leading a We Share Solar program in their school or organization in fall 2019. Our program targets grade 7-12 STEM school programs or after-school programs. We Share Solar aims to reach students typically underrepresented in STEM, particularly girls and minorities.

What: A two-day hands-on professional development training program for educators to learn how to build a Solar Suitcase and implement solar and global energy access curriculum. Program participants receive Solar Suitcase student kits and tools to equip their program, including deployment of built systems to a developing country.

Where: Minneapolis, MN (venue TBD)
